

**MOOSABEC COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT  
SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Jonesport, Maine  
May 4, 2006

A meeting of the Moosabec CSD School Committee was held at the Superintendent of Schools Office on May 4, 2006, with members present as follows: Harry Fish Jr., Colon Alley, Clifford Norton III, Mariner Bunker, Sylvina Lyons, Bethanie Beal, Linda Durkee and Julie Farris (7:45 p.m.). Also present was Principal/Superintendent Colleen Haskell.

Harry Fish Jr. called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

1. Approval of Minutes of April 20, 2006

The School Committee voted (7-0) to approve the minutes of April 20, 2006.

2. Teaching Position Elimination

The Superintendent recommended the elimination of the full-time industrial arts teaching position held by Arnold Smith.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to accept the recommendation.

3. Teacher Nomination(s)

The Superintendent nominated Arnold Smith for a two-year continuing contract for the position of part-time (50%) industrial arts teacher with schedule to be determined by the Principal/Superintendent.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to approve the nomination.

The Superintendent nominated Arnold Smith for a two-year continuing contract for the position of part-time (50%) gifted and talented teacher with schedule to be determined by the Principal/Superintendent.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to approve the nomination.

The Superintendent nominated Kathryn Beal for the position of part-time (2.5/7<sup>th</sup>) math teacher with schedule to be determined by the Principal/Superintendent and recommended her two-year continuing contract be amended to include such.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to approve the nomination.

4. Study Hall Monitor Position Elimination

The Superintendent recommended the elimination of the full-time study hall monitor position held by Jeanne Farnsworth.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to accept the recommendation.

5. Gifted and Talented Ed Tech II Position

The Superintendent recommended Jeanne Farnsworth for the position of gifted and talented educational technician II for the 2006-2007 school year at 27.5 hours per week while school is in session with schedule to be determined by the Principal/Superintendent.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to accept the recommendation.

6. Diploma Request

It was the consensus of the School Committee to consider diploma request(s) on an individual basis.

7. Policy JL – Student Wellness and Policy JL-R – Student Wellness Administrative Procedure

The School Committee voted (7-0-1) to accept policies JL – Student Wellness and JL-R – Student Wellness Administrative Procedure as presented.

8. 2006-2007 Budget Worksession

The Superintendent recommended Jeanne Farnsworth for the position of detention monitor for the 2006-2007 school year at 5 hours per week while school is in session with schedule to be determined by the Principal/Superintendent.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to accept the recommendation.

It was the consensus of the School Committee to pursue the purchase of a new school bus.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to accept a total 2006-2007 school budget of \$1,204,916.62.

The School Committee voted (8-0) to re-schedule the Moosabec CSD budget meeting for Tuesday, May 30, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. at Jonesport-Beals High School.

9. Coaching Selection Committee Appointment

It was the consensus of the School Committee to have Mariner Bunker, Clifford Norton III and Colon Alley serve as members of the coaching selection committee for 2006-2007.

10. Principal's Report

It was the consensus of the School Committee to have the art teacher apply for the PAL grant.

11. Miscellaneous

The School Committee voted (8-0) to allow Joshua Backman and Shafay Look to serve as volunteers for the baseball and softball teams.
