SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Jonesport, Maine

June 04, 2009

A meeting of the Jonesport School Committee was held at the Superintendent of Schools Office on Thursday, June 04, 2009 with members present as follows: Julie Farris(7:15), Clifford Norton III and Ernest Kelley Jr. Also present were Supervising Principal Michael Kelley, Teacher Leader Robert Alley, Superintendent of Schools Colleen Haskell.

The meeting was called to order at (7:02) p.m.

1. Approval of the Minutes of May 21, 2009.

The School Committee voted (2-0) to approve the minutes of May 21, 2009 as submitted.

3. Meal Prices

The School Committee voted (2-0) to set the prices for lunch and breakfast for the 2009-2010 school year as follows:

4. July/August Meetings

The Superintendent informed the School Committee that at this time there were no items requiring regularly scheduled July and August board meetings.

It was the consensus of the School Committee to leave it to the discretion of the Superintendent to notify the board of any items requiring a meeting and to schedule such a meeting throughout the summer months as needed. The School Committee authorized the Superintendent to hire any needed personnel with approval at the next board meeting.

5. Coaches

The Superintendent recommended Jason Mawson for the position of soccer coach.

The School Committee voted (2-0) to accept the recommendation of the Superintendent.

The Superintendent recommended Trisha Kelley for the position of cross country coach.

The School Committee voted (2-0) to accept the recommendation of the Superintendent.

The Superintendent recommended Arlin Alley and Allan Alley, Jr. for the position of grades 6-8 boys' basketball coach.

The School Committee voted (3-0) to accept the recommendation of the Superintendent.

The Superintendent recommended Patrick Kelley for the position of pee wee boys' basketball.

The School Committee voted (2-0-1) to accept the recommendation of the Superintendent according to policy BCC Nepotism.

The Superintendent recommended Troy Alley for the position of grades 6-8 girls' basketball.

The School Committee voted (2-1-0) to accept the recommendation of the Superintendent.

The Superintendent recommended Misty Kelley for the position of pee wee cheering coach.

The School Committee voted (2-0-1) to accept the recommendation of the Superintendent according to policy BCC Nepotism.

6. After School Snack Contract

The School Committee voted (3-0) to enter into a food service contract with Beals School Department for the purchase of after school snacks for the EDGE program at the cost of \$.71 per snack. The contract will be reviewed annually with snack prices subject to change if the price per snacks proves insufficient to cover actual meal costs.

8. Miscellaneous

A. Truck Purchase

A discussion was held regarding purchasing a new truck.

It was the consensus of the School Committee to put this item on a future agenda.

B. Response to Intervention (RTI)

The Superintendent presented a letter from the teachers and staff of Jonesport Elementary School.

It was the consensus of the School Committee to have the Superintendent respond in writing to outline proper procedure and possible scenarios for RTI planning.

C. Letter from PTO

It was the consensus of the School Committee to allow the PTO to proceed with the playground project and to have the Superintendent write a letter to the PTO in response to the request.

2. Student Disciplinary Matter

A motion and a second were made by the Chairman to move this item to the end of the agenda.

The School Committee voted (3-0) to enter executive session at 8:30 p.m. pursuant to 20-A M.R.S.A. §405 §§6-E.

The School Committee returned to regular session at 9:35 p.m.

Student Disciplinary Matter, continued

A motion and second were made to expel the student under consideration.

The School Committee voted (3-0) to expel the student under consideration effective immediately, that the student not be allowed on school property or at school activities without the prior written consent of the Superintendent, and that the Superintendent provide the student and his parents with the board's written findings and decision.
