SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

A meeting of the Beals School Committee was held at the Beals Town Office on Tuesday, June 18, 2019 with members present as follows: Frank Alley, Debbie Kelley and Mariner Bunker. Also present were Principal Christopher Crowley and Superintendent of Schools Denis Howard.

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m.

1. Approval of the Minutes of May 21, 2019

The School Committee voted (3-0-0) to approve the minutes of May 21, 2019.

2. 2019-2020 ESEA Grant Application

The School Committee voted (3-0) to authorize the Superintendent to submit the ESEA grant for 2019-2020.

3 Director of Special Education Salary for 2019-2020

The School Committee voted (3-0-0) to set the Director of Special Education salary at \$38,127.30 (3/5ths x \$63,545.50) with Beals contributing 25%; Jonesport contributing 36% and Moosabec contributing 39% for the 2019-2020 year.

4. Principal's Salary for 2019-2020

The Principal received no increase at his request. His salary will remain at \$42,567.00.

5. Meal Prices

The School Committee voted (3-0-0) to set the prices for lunch and breakfast for the 2019-2020 school year as follows:
