SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

A meeting of the Beals School Committee was held at the Superintendent of Schools Office on Wednesday, June 06, 2018 with members present as follows: Debbie Kelley, Frank Alley and Mariner Bunker. Also present were Principal Christopher Crowley and Superintendent of Schools Denis L. Howard.

The meeting was called to order at (5:22) p.m.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

The Superintendent opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Approval of the Minutes of May 02, 2018

The School Committee voted (3-0) to approve the minutes of May 02, 2018 as presented.

3. 2018-2019 School Calendar

The School Committee voted (3-0) to approve the 2018-2019 calendar as presented.

4. 2018-2019 ESEA Grant

The School Committee voted (3-0) to authorize the Superintendent to submit the 2018-2019 ESEA grant.

5. 2018-2019 Fuel Bid

Bids were reviewed from the following:

Dead River Company-\$2.4366 fixed price per gallon;

R.H. Foster Energy Fuels-\$2.475 fixed price per gallon to lock in.

The School Committee voted (3-0) to accept the bid submitted by Dead River Company at a lock in price of \$2.4366 for up to 35,250 gallons for the 2018-2019 school year.

6. Hourly Support Staff

The Superintendent recommended Crystal Blackwood for the position of administrative assistant to the Principal for the 2018-2019 school year placing her on step three of the hourly support staff scale.

The School Committee voted (3-0) to accept the recommendation.

7. Authorization to Hire

The School Committee voted (3-0) to authorize the Superintendent to hire for any vacancies with approval at the next regular scheduled meeting.

8. Budget Work Session

The School Committee voted (3-0) to accept the 2018-2019 school budget as presented in the amount of \$895,894.02 and to schedule the annual town budget meeting for June 19, 2018.
