Also present were Principal Christopher Crowley, School Nurse Holly Swilo and Superintendent of Schools Lewis Collins.

The meeting was called to order at 5:26 p.m.

1. Approval of the Minutes of January 8, 2020 and March 16th 2020:

4. Continuing Contract Teachers – Recommendation for Continued Employment:

The Superintendent recommended the continued employment of the following teachers for the 2020-2021 school year:

Suzanne Fox – Special Education;
Laura Fish – Grade 5-8 English/Language Arts (Part-time 3.5/7ths) and Title IA Reading and Math (Part-time 3.5/7ths) with percentages to be adjusted according to federal funding;
George Crawford Gr. 3-4 Math/Science/Health;
Eileen Pulkinnen – Grades Pre-K & Kindergarten;
Kristi Carver-Kenney – Grades 5-8 math, science and health;
Daniel Campbell – Physical Education (Part-time 15%);
Tamra Lenfestey – Title IA Reading and Math (Part-time 1/7th).

3. 2020-2021 Hourly Support Staff – Recommendation for Continued Employment:

4. Director of Special Education Contract for 2020-2021:

The Superintendent recommended Steve Peer as part-time (2/5ths) director of special education for the 2020-2021 year with a total district salary of \$26,689.11 (2/5ths x \$66,722.78). The Superintendent further recommended cost sharing for the position to be determined by the districts cost sharing percentages for the current year, which for 2020-2021 are as follows: Moosabec – 37.8623%; Jonesport – 38.6647%; Beals – 23.4730%.

The School Committee voted (2-0-0) to approve a total school budget for 2020-2021 year in the amount of \$943,809.54. Mariner Bunker and Debbie Kelley both voted "aye".

School re-opening and safety measures for re-opening are among the topics the statewide group is working on.
