1. Approval of the Minutes of June 18, 2019

The School Committee voted 2-0 to approve the minutes of June 18, 2019.

2. Nepotism Waiver

The School Committee voted (2-0) to make an exception to the Nepotism policy to permit the hiring of LeAnn Crowley as school custodian.

3. Custodian Vacancy

The Superintendent recommended LeAnn Crowley as part-time custodian at 15 hours per week for the remainder of the 2019-2020 year.

The School Committee voted (2-0-0) to accept the recommendation.

4. Principal's Secretary Job Description

Mr. Collins noted that the new Support Staff Contract requires a committee be formed to develop all new job descriptions and this will be forwarded to them for consideration.

5. Coaches

A. Cross-Country

The Superintendent recommended Naomi Chandler as cross-country coach for the 2019-2020 year.

The School Committee voted (2-0-0) to accept the recommendation.

B. Soccer

The Superintendent informed the School Committee that there were insufficient numbers to field a soccer team and that students would be participating on the Jonesport soccer team. The team is coached by Arlin Alley and Beals will be contributing to half of his salary.
