SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

A meeting of the Moosabec CSD School Committee was held at Jonesport-Beals High School on April 16, 2015 with members present as follows: Ernest Kelley Jr., Clifford Norton III, Frank Alley, Daniel Harden, Calvin Beal, Wilma Jones and Loren Faulkingham.
