SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

August 8, 2018

A meeting of the Moosabec CSD School Committee was held at Jonesport-Beals High School on August 8, 2018 with members present as follows: Julie Farris, Ernest Kelley Jr., Clifford Norton III, Debbie Kelley and Loren Faulkingham. Also present were Sandra Wakefield, Holly Swilo, Principal Michael Kelley and Superintendent of Schools Denis Howard.

Ernest Kelley Jr. called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

The Superintendent opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Approval of Minutes of July 18, 2018

The School Committee voted (5-0-0) to approve the minutes of July 18, 2018.

3. Presentation – School Based Healthcare

The Superintendent introduced Sandra Wakefield of the Harrington Health Center and Holly Swilo, school nurse. Sandra made a slide presentation and she and Holly answered questions. This school based health care is another resource for schools to use to meet the needs of students. Funding is done by a three year grant and at the end of the grant will apply again. The only cost to our schools is a space for an examining table. Parental permission will be required for services. This is another way to connect schools to the community.

The School Committee voted (5-0-0) to accept the School Based Healthcare (SBHC) proposal for the 2018-2019 school year.

4. Request for Proposals – Project Learning Workshop/Storage Building

The School Committee reviewed the one bid submitted by King Construction Services Inc. in the amount of \$149,239.00.

The Chairman stated that a contractor that did not submit a bid may be willing to do so in the future.

The School Committee voted (5-0-0) to reject the King Construction Services Inc. bid in the amount of \$149,239.00 due to financial constraints.
