Ernest Kelley Jr. called the meeting to order at 5:31p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Approval of Minutes of September 18, 2019

6. 8th Graders Participation at JV Level

The Superintendent informed the Board that the Beals School Committee and Jonesport School Committee previously voted not to permit 8th graders to play at varsity level.

7. Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan

Principal Kelley informed the Board that he has updated the plan to include new phones numbers and staff.
