SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

A meeting of the Jonesport School Committee was held at the Superintendent of Schools Office on Wednesday, November 6, 2019 with members present as follows: Julie Farris, Ernest Kelley Jr. and Suzen Polk-Hoffses. Also present were Principal Melissa Tenney and Superintendent of Schools Lewis Collins.

The meeting was called to order at 6:06 p.m.

1. Approval of the Minutes of September 11, 2019
