A meeting of the Jonesport School Committee was held at the Jonesport Elementary School on Wednesday, May 24, 2017 with members present as follows: Julie Farris and Ernest Kelley, Jr. Also present were Principal Debra Lay and Superintendent of Schools Beth Anne Lorigan.

The meeting was called to order at (6:45) p.m.

1. Approval of the Minutes of May 03, 2017

The School Committee voted (2-0) to approve the minutes with the minutes of May 03, 2017 as presented.

2. Fuel Bid

Bids were reviewed from the following: Dead River Company - \$1.7395 fixed price per gallon; R.H. Foster Energy Fuels - \$1.737 fixed price per gallon to lock in; Carver Heating - \$.07 over race price on day of delivery, no lock in offered.

The School Committee voted (2-0) to accept the bid submitted by R.H. Foster Energy Fuels at a lock in price of \$1.737 for up to 35,250 gallons for the 2017-2018 year.

Principal Lay told the board about a trip proposed by Colleen Haskell (DEI) that would involve students going by boat to an island near Jonesport. She asked what the School Committee would need for her to move forward for plans for the event. The Board agreed for us to move forward on this and agreed that it would be an excellent opportunity for the students.
