## **SCHOOL SOCIAL EVENTS - DANCE**

- I. Teachers or Coaches requesting a dance should do so at least seven (7) days prior to the date desired. Dances are limited to no more than two (2) per month.
- II. All dances are under the direct supervision of a faculty member or coach of Beals Elementary School. Being a school activity they fall under the policies, regulations and administration of the school.
- III. Dances held at and sponsored by Beals Elementary School are intended for the benefit of its students and activities; and will be restricted to students of this school and are to meet the following conditions:
  - 1. Dances are to be held on Friday evenings or other nights prior to non-school days. Time is set at 7:00-10:00 p.m.
  - 2. There must be a minimum of two chaperones per dance.
  - 3. There will be no food or drink allowed in the gymnasium, except when permission has been granted by the principal.
  - 4. Dances are limited to grades 5 through 8 of Beals Elementary School and at the discretion of the Principal and the chaperones, students in grades 5-8 at Jonesport Elementary. Each eighth grade student may invite one guest from neighboring schools grades 5-9, but is held accountable for actions of his/her guest.
  - 5. Names of invited students are to be submitted to the principal for approval one week before the scheduled dance.
  - 6. Students are to remain in the building at all times. Once a student leaves, he/she will not be allowed to return unless prior permission is received from the teacher or coach, who is providing the direct supervision.
  - 7. In the event of problems involving elementary students they will lose their right to attend future dances for up to the remainder of the school year.
  - 8. In the event of problems involving invited guests they will lose their privilege of attending future functions.
  - 9. The decision of the principal regarding invited guests is final.
  - 10. The teacher/coach providing the direct supervision will ensure the gymnasium is left in the same order as it was in before the dance.
