

TOBACCO-FREE SCHOOLS

In order to promote health and safety of all students and staff and to promote the cleanliness of all facilities, the Board prohibits smoking and the use of all other tobacco products by all persons in school buildings, grounds and on school buses at all times. This includes e-cigarettes. When school is in session, smoking and the use of all other tobacco products is prohibited on school grounds by all persons, including students and employees.

In addition, students are further prohibited from possessing, selling, distributing or dispensing tobacco products in school buildings, facilities and on school grounds and buses during school-sponsored events and at all other times.

Employees and all other persons are also strictly prohibited, under law and this Board's policy, from selling, distributing or in any way dispensing tobacco products to students.
